2 What Cisco product competes with this? What is the price of the comparable Cisco product? Is this made in York, PA?	The Cisco IE-1000 is very similar and yes, built in York, PA.
3 Support for port mirroring/SPAN, and RSPAN?	Port mirroring has been improved in the NT5000. You'll be able to mirror ports or VLANs
4 Hi. Is it planned to "refresh" Crimson NView driver ?	We look to the automation team on that. They will hopefully make a decision for the long term.
5 Right, I meant in the series that support Profinet	NT4008 supports PROFINET. However, not this particular switch at this moment in time.
6 What about DLR?	Unfortunately, no. We have our own ring protocols.
